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## June/July 2015 VACATION CARE

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- Bookings <u>MUST</u> be received no later than **9am on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June** in order to confirm your booking without a late booking surcharge. After this date, no cancellations are possible. Online bookings can be made up until **Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> June.** Bookings can be made after this by contacting the centre by email.
- Parents please note that if you intend receive CCR (Child Care Rebate which is a 50% government rebate for ALL fees paid) OR CCB, you must provide the centre with a completed and correct enrolment form.
- Please be aware that ALL bookings are made online via our website. You must log in using your username and password and navigate to the appropriate section to make and change you booking.
- ALL bookings taken and ALL changes made to your booking AFTER the cut off date applicable to your booking (noted above) are payable and incur a \$5 surcharge per child, per day.
- Please complete the permission section on page 1 of this notice and return it to the Centre. This form IS NOT your booking, you will still be required to book online via our webserver. Signed permission slips can be returned via email, directly to the Centre.
- This Vacation Care period, all excursion days are capped at a Maximum of 45 children, in-centre days are 65. Please book quickly to avoid disappointment.

**HOURS:** The centre is open from 7.00 am until 6.00 pm. Late fees apply for late pick-ups as per the parent handbook (if you do not have a copy please ask us for one).

**MEALS:** Breakfast is available until 8:30 am, afternoon tea is provided and some days as specified in the program we will supply lunch. Although the program may specify the Centre's provision of lunch, we advise you provide your child with morning tea and lunch EVERY day. This ensures that your child will have plenty of food for the day.

**SIGNING IN AND OUT:** Children must be signed in and out of the centre, when dropped off and picked up, by a responsible adult, each day they attend (as per our centre policies). Please note that this does not include brothers or sisters of children who are under 18 years of age, as well as those not on your child's authorised collection list (unless specifically authorised prior). All people collecting your children other than their parent/guardian need to supply our staff with photo I.D. **If you don't have your username and password and staff need to sign your children in/out, you may incur a sign in/out fee.** 

CHECK LIST: Each day, all children should bring:

- $\Rightarrow$  Morning tea, lunch and drinks unless otherwise specified in the program

 $\Rightarrow$  Suitable clothing and footwear for outdoor games and craft activities (includes enclosed shoes and sun-safe clothing)

 $\Rightarrow$  Wet weather gear for excursions (if applicable)

**FOR ALL DAYS INVOLVING EXCURSIONS**: : <u>Children should be at the Centre no later than 9am!</u> Even if we intend to leave later than this there are many important things that need to be done before we leave the Centre. This includes issuing the children with details and instructions about the excursion for the safety and well-being of everyone in attendance. We will always endeavor to be back at the Centre by 3pm. Please do not give your children any money to spend on the excursion as it is not fair to children without money. Please ensure to give your child a packed lunch and water. Travel will by a charted bus as specified on the booking form and permission notice. If you require more information about any of the excursions please speak to a staff member.</u>
