PROGRAM

Through regular evaluation, our program continues to change and support the out of school hours needs of our children. Our Term 1 2019 programmed activities were as follows:

The observations of your children and the identification of their needs (by our cohort of trained educators) assists in informing our program in order to best suit the children in our care. ADMINISTRATION

The Centre has recently been inundated with gueries from families who are having difficulties with their CCS (Child Care Subsidy). The most common problem we are seeing is that the CRN (Client Reference Number) for the parent registered for CCS has not been provided. Instead, families have provided the centre with the other parents CRN. This means that CCS has not been flowing for the family. Please note that this requires you setting up a completely new enrolment with the correct CRN. In these instances, your family will be charged an additional membership fee for the set up of this new account. There may also be other administration fees associated with retrieving lost CCS. Please note, that back-dating of CCS will not be possible at all after the end of this financial year, and the backdating does not guarantee CCS refund. We encourage all our families to regularly log in to MyGov and become familiar with the systems involved. We also ask you to check your fortnightly statements to ensure CCS has been applied to your fees.

If you are not receiving a fortnightly emailed statement from administration, please contact the centre to confirm your email address.

If your child is going to be away in before care, after care or vacation care, you MUST let us know to avoid additional charges. Please refer to our parent handbook available on our website: www.eppingheightoshc.com.au
