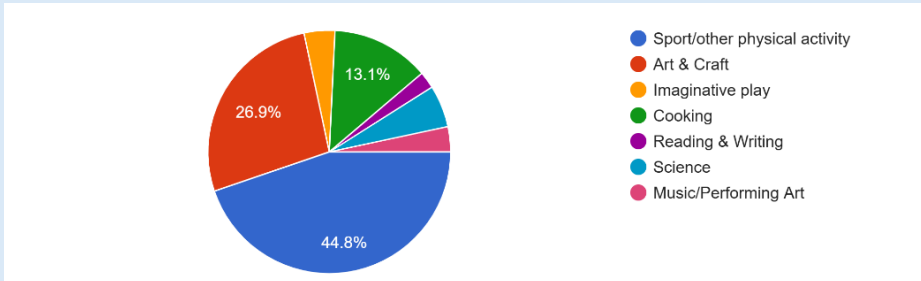


2025 Interest Form Results

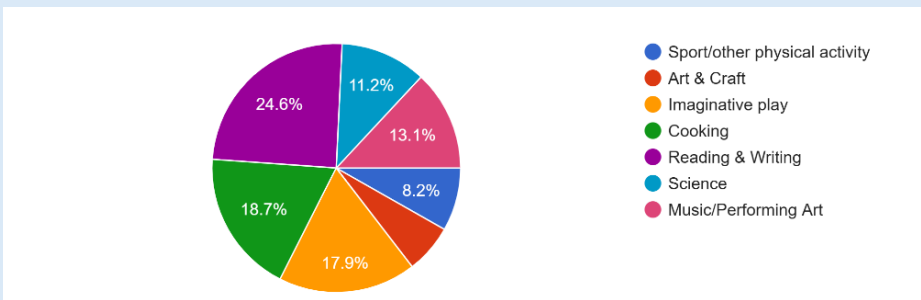

My child's preferred activity is:



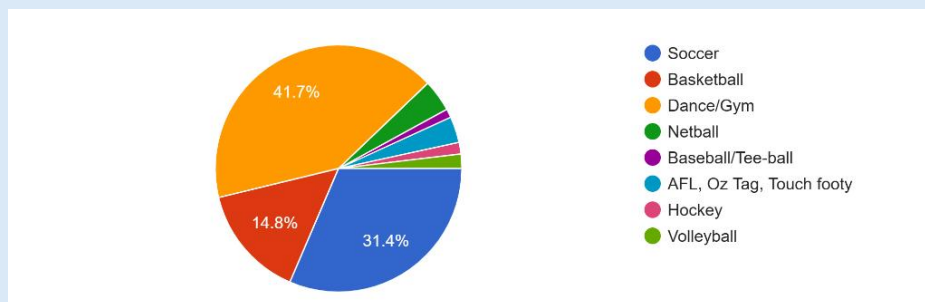
A large majority of children prefer sport as their session activity, followed by art and craft and cooking activities.

The least preferred activity was reading and writing with 25% of children not liking it. Most other activities were evenly spread as a not preferred activity.

The most preferred sports were **dance/gymnastics, soccer and basketball.**

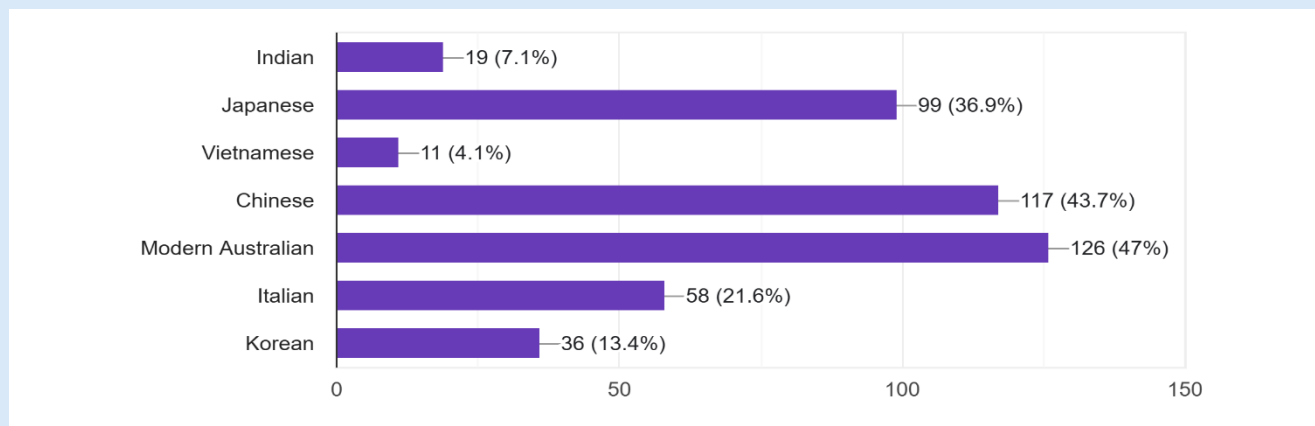
At OSHC we promote a range of different sports for the children to try including rugby, frisbee and netball.

Additional support for children

Most parents selected that their children didn't require additional support in any areas, however the second two areas chosen were **reading and writing** (14% each) and then **social skills and maths** (9%) each.

These skills are vital for students to develop early, and at OSHC we are able to help facilitate more practice and learning in these areas so that students can thrive in the classroom. Throughout the year, more activities like letter writing, library activities and quiz cards are programmed to ensure children are learning in play-based activities to improve upon these skills.
